Notes:

Age Categories:

- Age is the number years which the player will have in 2013
- Men singles: under 55, over 55
- Men Doubles - sum of players' Ages: under 100, over 100
- Woman singles – one category
- Mixed Doubles

❖ RR (Round Robin)

- each player/team plays against every other player/team within the group.
- no final match – order is defined by group ranking
- in the case that 2 players/teams have same number of wins their respective match will be the deciding factor for group ranking
- in case that 3 or more players/teams have the same number of wins, the team with the lowest number of lost games in the matches among these teams will be ranked higher. Furthermore, in case that two teams have the same number of lost games, their respective match is looked upon as deciding factor and in the case that three or more teams have the same number of lost games, the lowest overall number of lost games in the deciding factor.
- Tie-break is counted in the all games.
